Established in 1923, SERS is one of the nation's oldest and largest retirement plans for public employees, with more than 239,000 members. As of Sept. 30, 2023, SERS' Defined Benefit Plan had assets of approximately \$34.4 billion and the Defined Contribution Plan had approximately \$155 million. SERS also administers a voluntary supplemental Deferred Compensation Plan with nearly 57,000 participants and assets of approximately \$4.1 billion as of Sept. 30, 2023.
