> PPMAIRC UPDATE

Chris Houston and Jeff Meyer of SERS provided the Investment Committee with a PPMAIRC update. As a result of this discussion, a motion by the Investment Committee, cast by Committee Chair Glenn Becker and seconded by Assistant Committee Chair David Fillman, was made as follows for PPMAIRC Recommendation #100 (Procurement of Investment Managers):

RESOLVED: That the Investment Committee recommend that the State Employees' Retirement Board direct SERS' investment office staff to implement the following to enhance the current process for hiring public market managers:

- Post an announcement in a timely manner to SERS' website that SERS is seeking a manager with a certain mandate, e.g. large cap value manager.
- Post a similar announcement on the website of SERS' general investment consultant requesting managers to enter/update such consultant's database by a certain agreed upon date.
- Advertise the announcement using Twitter, LinkedIn, and industry publications.

RESOLVED: That the Investment Committee recommend that the State Employees' Retirement Board amend the Investment Policy Statement to provide that a Request for Information (RFI) process is to be used for the hiring of general and specialty investment consultants, with the following requirements:

- (a) All RFIs are to be posted on SERS' website; and
- (b) Once a contract has been entered into with the selected consultant, post on SERS' website the selected consultant's proposal received in response to the RFI, with redactions consistent with those made for proposals received pursuant to the Procurement Code, as set forth in the *Procurement Handbook Part I Chapter 50 Public Access to Procurement Information*.
