

DEFINED BENEFIT PLAN - TRADITIONAL PENSION

PROOF OF BIRTHDATE

In order to process your pension transaction, we need proof of your birthdate. A **birth certificate**/birth registration form, **baptismal record**, or valid* signed **passport**, **Real ID** issued by any state or US territory (Guam, Puerto Rico, etc.) or **Global Entry Card** is acceptable.

If you do not have one of those documents, we may also accept a combination of **any two of the following** documents:

- Valid driver's license
- Valid state-issued non-driver photo identification card
- Selective Service record
- · Armed Forces discharge
- School record
- Life insurance policy
- · Naturalization record
- Alien registration record
- Social Security record issued by the Social Security Administration
- Marriage record
- Federal Census record
- Physician's or midwife's record of birth
- · Bible or other family record

Your Original Documents Will Be Returned

After SERS staff makes a copy of your birthdate documentation for your record, the original document or documents will be returned to you.

Notarized Documentation Also Accepted

You may also provide a copy of any of the documentation listed above that has been notarized by a notary public attesting to the fact that they have seen the original document.
