## Pennsylvania State Employees' Retirement System

Established in 1923, SERS is one of the nation's oldest and largest retirement plans for public employees, with more than 240,000 members. As of Aug. 31, 2021, SERS' Defined Benefit Plan had net assets of nearly \$39 billion and the Defined Contribution Plan, which launched on Jan. 1, 2019, had nearly \$66 million. SERS also administers a voluntary supplemental Deferred Compensation Plan with more than 57,600 participants and net assets of nearly \$4.8 billion as of Aug. 31, 2021.
